We often see our customers choosing top brands for their products which isn't always necessary, but it's a question of personal choice against price. The saving between standard Post-It notes and own brand are vast, and more often than not, you can't tell the difference.

Quedgeley Medical Centre is a small practice based in Quedgeley, Gloucester a population of around 6,500 patients.

We have two GP partners, a nurse, two HCAs, and a great team of reception and admin staff. We also host locum GPs; care coordinators; a mental health nurse; social prescribers, a physiotherapist and pharmacists. We are a really friendly team and enjoy socialising as well as working together.

Our GPs are passionate about training the next generation of doctors and this involves having a rotation of students

who come in bi-weekly together with trainee doctors on a four-month rotational basis. Gap year students who are applying to medical school also use this year to come to work with us and get an all-round experience of working in a GP practice setting.

We are currently in the process of having a three-sided extension built to help accommodate the growing population of Quedgeley with GP services. This is a huge undertaking and we have had to make quite a few adjustments to our way of working as this work progresses around us. We have also opened up our books in order for more patients to be able to register and in turn are taking on more staff to help with this.

My role is Operations Manager and I came into the post in January 2022. I have worked for the NHS for almost 28 years in many health settings including hospitals; family planning clinics; Health Authorities and GP practices. I have seen so many changes over the years and the challenges can be really difficult but I absolutely love this job and am very proud to work for the NHS.

One element of my role is ordering items required for the day to day running of the practice including stationery; cleaning products; tea and coffee etc. This used to be done on an adhoc basis by whoever was going shopping at the cash and carry or the local supermarket. This was fine when the practice was smaller but as we are continuing to grow in staff numbers it was becoming more difficult and not a great use of people's time popping back and forth to the shops.

We discovered Officeworx when a colleague needed a specific type of printer label and they were able to help with this. We found them so helpful and efficient that we thought we would try out an order and I am so glad we did.
